## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

For reporting market observations and standard assessment we have put up two Web 2.0 instruments: a blog and a wiki respectively. The key idea is to provide the LarKC project with information regarding real-world developments and trends in the markets of Information Retrieval and Reasoning including: key business challenges, emerging products and solutions and vendor landscapes.

For the entire duration of the project all partners involved in LarKC will

- continuously publish concise summary reports on relevant market developments through the blog and collect standards related to LarKC and to analyze them and to provide a continuous updated assessment, and
- collect, analyze and assessing standards related to LarKC through the wiki.

As a consortium we decided that the blog and the wiki could be used for more than WP9 purposes, they can serve as dissemination vehicle for LarKC findings. Thus we offered the infrastructure for any other usage the consortium would envisage. So far the blog was also use as a place for discussing problem of general interest (e.g., Reasoning Requirements of the Urban Computing) and the decision was taken to use the wiki at least also for WP8 (e.g. training events) and WP10 (e.g., minutes of telconfs) purposes.

In particular, the blog is a one way communication mechanism organized in diary style that follows a temporal flow, whereas the wiki is structured as follows:

- External area [read by world (for dissemination and incentives), written by project (quality control)], which will include technical topic list/hierarchy, dissemination events, training events
- Internal, divided in section (one per WP) and subsections (one per Deliverable) and including admin info (deliverable skeleton, bimonthly forms, logos, etc.)

In order to monitor who is visiting the two Web 2.0 instruments and what they put attention to, we will

- monitor recent changes page in the wiki (<http://wiki.larkc.eu/RecentChanges>),
- collect statistics about blog visits (visitors, spiders, search keywords, feeds, browsers), and
- provide a short report in each WP9 contribution to LarKC QMR.

The blog is accessible at <http://blog.larkc.eu/> whereas the wiki is accessible at <http://wiki.larkc.eu/>. Passwords were created for each person participating to the project and they were distributed.
